Syllabus:

I. <u>General Cooking Knowledge</u>: General Knowledge on Cooking.

II. <u>General Awareness</u>: Question will be designed to test the ability of the candidate's general awareness of the environment around him and its application to society. Question will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observation and experience in their scientific aspects as may be expected of an educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighboring countries especially pertaining to History, Culture, Geography, Economic scene, General Polity and Scientific Research.

Common General Knowledge on Hygiene and Health.

III. <u>General Intelligence</u>: The question will be of Matriculation Standard and would include both verbal and non-verbal type. The test may include question on analogies, similarities, differences, space visualization, visual memory, discrimination observation, relationship concept. Matriculation standard Arithmetic.
