<b>Essential Qualifications</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. 10<sup>th</sup> class pass from recognized Board/ Institution.</li> <li>2. Must have completed basic course on elementary Fire Fighting from a recognized Institute. ( The duration of the basic Fire Fighting course will not be less than 06 months. The Institute should be recognized by State Govt. / Govt. of India.)</li> <li>3. Must be Physically fit and capable of performing strenuous duties. This requirement will be tested as under :-             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) Height ( Without Shoes) – 165 cms.</li> <li>(b) Chest ( Unexpanded – 81.5 cms &amp; Expanded -- 85 cms. )</li> <li>(c) Weight 50 kgs minimum</li> </ol> </li> </ol> <p><b>Note : Concession of 2.5 cms in height or chest may be allowed for the members of Schedule Castes or Schedule Tribes candidates from hill areas.</b></p>
<b>Endurance Test</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Carrying a man (Fireman lift of 63.5 kgs to a distance of 183 mtrs within 96 seconds).</li> <li>(b) Clearing 2.7 mtrs wide ditch landing on both feet (long jumps)</li> <li>(c) Climbing 3 mtrs. Vertical rope using hands and feet .</li> </ol>

## SCHEME OF WRITTEN EXAMINATION :-

The written examination consists of one **objective type multiple choice question** paper of **150 marks** as shown below :

### 1. Syllabus of Written Examination :

**I. General Intelligence :** The question will be of 10<sup>th</sup> Standard and would include both verbal and non-verbal type. The test may include question on analogies, similarities and differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making, visual memory, discrimination observation, relationship concept, figure classification, arithmetical number series, verbal and non-verbal series and mathematics of 10<sup>th</sup> standard . The test will also include questions designed to test the candidates abilities to deal with abstract ideas and symbols and their relationship, mathematical computation and other analytical functions.

**II. General Awareness :** The question will be of 10<sup>th</sup> Standard. Question will be designed to test the ability of the candidate's general awareness of the environment around him and its application to society. Question will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observation and experience in their scientific aspects as may be expected of a 10<sup>th</sup> standard educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighboring countries especially pertaining to Sports, History, Culture, Geography, Economic scene, General Polity including Indian Constitution and Scientific Research etc. These questions will be such that, they do not require a special study of any discipline.

**III. General Awareness on Fire Fighting :** This test will include questions on knowledge of Fire Fighting, operational use of Fire Fighting Equipments, life saving drills, cause of Fire etc.

## **2. Measurement of Physical Standards Test & Endurance Test :-**

The number of candidates to be called for the measurement of Physical Standards test & endurance test on the basis of merit in the written test shall be in the ratio of 1:10 to the number of vacancies . The physical standards measurement test & endurance test are only of qualifying nature.

(a) **Measurement of Physical Standards Test** : (as specified in the SRO )

(b) **Endurance Test** : ( as specified in the SRO ) Endurance Test shall be done only for those candidates who qualify in the measurement of physical standards.

3. Final grading will be decided based on marks obtained in written test subject to qualifying in the measurement of physical standards test & Endurance test.
