SCHEME OF WRITTEN TEST :- The written Examination consists of one objective type multiple choice question paper of 100 Marks as shown below :-

Note:- All the Questions will be compulsory. There will be no negative marking.

Syllabus:

(A) General Science (10 Questions)

Question will be aimed at testing the General Awareness of the candidate's environment around him. Question will also be designed to test knowledge of basic science studied upto 10th standard and would include such matter of every day observations and experience as may be expected of any educated person.

(B) Quantitative Aptitude (10 Questions)

The Candidate will be tested for general mathematics of upto 10th standard involving number system, equations in two variables, simple and compound interest, perimeter, area and volume of geometrical figures, Direct and inverse proportions, Pythagoras theorem and Trigonometry.

(C) NCVT Trade (80 Questions)

Questions from the NCVT Syllabus of relevant trade.

Mode of Selection

Written Test of 100 marks:- Written test of 100 marks shall be fully "objective-multiple-choice-type" and OMR based.

Trade test (Qualifying only- No marks):- The syllabus for the trade test (practical) will be as per trade test specification of the Semi-skilled grade of the relevant trade.

On the basis of merit in written test, candidates to the extent of 1.25 times of the number of vacancies shall be called for the trade test. The result of the written test will be published in alphabetic order of names of the candidates to be called for the Trade test. **Final Selection/Merit will be based on marks obtained only in written test subject to qualifying in the prescribed trade test (practical).**
